Requirements to attend EVA2010 - Peace Academy

Registration via the EVA application form creates a contract concerning the attendance of the Peace Academy EVA2010 between the Frauenkirche Dresden foundation and the applicant. In the case of group registration the contract counts for each of the group members by whom the person signing claims to be authorized.

The festival ticket enables the holder to visit the whole festival from May 21st-24th 2010; a place on a certain workshop cannot be guaranteed. For several workshops a reservation can be placed from the beginning of April. The festival pass includes accommodation in a shared room and breakfast during the time of the festival (three nights) in the Jugendgästehaus, the Ev. Jugendbildungsstätte, CVJM Jugendschiff or the City Herberge in Dresden (all different youth hostels).

The reduced price applies to students, trainees, unemployed people or young people doing a year of civil or social service. Proof of this status is to be shown at registration.

People joining EVA from foreign countries must be at least 18 years old. The host undertakes no responsibility for their supervision.

Each ticket is valid for one person only and for the whole time of the Peace Academy. Discounts for groups, daily tickets or a refund (even in part) in the case of shortened attendance will not be possible.

Places for EVA2010 are limited and will be issued in order of payment received. After the registration using the application form we will send a bill via email or post. The application will only become contractually binding when the festival price is paid. As long as there are still remaining tickets, they can be bought on site.

Personal data as needed for the application/ attendance/ participation and possibly for staying overnight will be stored electronically. It will only be used for matters concerning the festival.

It will not be possible to refund tickets. The foundation is not responsible for mistakes which may result from the forms submitted. In case of loss or theft of attendees' belongings, including tickets, the foundation is only responsible in cases of intention or gross negligence of its personnel or representative. The same counts for damage to property or people.
